Pend Oreille County

Said approach will be constructed to comply with Pend Oreille County Resolution No. 74-99, and the current laws of Washington State, and the following specific requirements:

1. Applicant shall mark where they want the approach (flagging, stakes, etc)
2. All costs of construction of the approach to the county road shall be borne by the applicant.
3. Minimum width of any approach shall be 16' measured 6' beyond the shoulder of the existing county road.
4. The approach-way shall slope away from the shoulder of the county road with a minimum grade of 2% to a maximum of 8% grade for a distance of 6'.
5. No water or material used in construction of the approach shall drain or be carried onto the county road.
6. Maintenance of the approach, cleaning of culvert pipes and snow removal are the responsibility of the property owner.
7. Sight distance should be adequate for safety.
8. You should post your new address at the approach as soon as possible, call your fire district for placement directions, So they can find you in an emergency.
