A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE NORTHWOOD'S PERFORMING ARTS INC. CIRCLE MOON THEATRE SIGNAGE LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAY 2 AND HIGHWAY 211

WHEREAS, the Northwood's Performing Arts Inc. a private, nonprofit organization, would like to place and maintain a sign at the intersection of State Highway 2 and State Highway 211, giving directions to a theatre owned and operated by the Northwood's Performing Arts Inc. in Newport, WA; and

WHEREAS, the proposed signage must meet design criteria and regulations for signage by the Washington State Department of Transportation (DOT); and

WHEREAS, WAC 468-66-050 allows for directional signs for publicly or privately owned places that feature natural phenomena; historical, cultural, scientific, or educational opportunities; areas of scenic beauty, or outdoor recreation areas, and

WHEREAS, the signage is a directional sign for a privately owned, non-profit performing arts theatre of cultural value to the citizens of Pend Oreille County and visitors alike.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That it is the opinion and position of the Pend Oreille County Commissioners that the signage meets the requirements of the WAC for a directional sign for a privately owned place of cultural significance to the citizens of Pend Oreille County as well as visitors and that the sign should be allowed to be installed.
