

CONTRACT NO: 2016-4

**CONTRACT BETWEEN PEND OREILLE COUNTY AND PEND OREILLE  
COUNTY CRIME VICTIM SERVICES**

This contract is retroactive to and effective January 1, 2016, and shall continue from month to month until December 31, 2016.

**PURPOSE OF THIS CONTRACT**

Pend Oreille County has determined that a need exists to provide emergency services to county homeless. Homeless Prevention services include transportation and provision of essential needs such as food, toiletries, formula, information and referral to other shelters outside of Pend Oreille County.

1. **PROGRAM AND ADMINISTRATION:** It is anticipated by both parties that Pend Oreille County Crime Victim Services will provide the services under this contract.
2. **PAYMENT:** Because Pend Oreille County Crime Victim Services supports the goals of HB 2060, Pend Oreille County will utilize HB 2060 funds to support this program and will pay a maximum of \$15,000 during this twelve month period in response to monthly billings.

Because Pend Oreille County Crime Victim Services also supports the goals of HB 2163, Pend Oreille County will utilize HB 2163 funds to support this program and will pay a maximum of \$22,500 during this twelve month period in response to monthly billings.

Crime Victim Services will provide quarterly reports to the Board of County Commissioners providing sufficient details of the program activities to enable the Commissioners to evaluate the effectiveness of the various programs.


3. **MODIFICATIONS:** This Agreement may be modified in writing with the mutual consent of the parties.

4. **TERMINATION:** This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon ninety (90) days written notice to the other party.
5. **NONDISCRIMINATION:** Pend Oreille County Crime Victim Services shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for contracted employment because of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age, marital status, or the presence of any physical, sensory or mental disability. Pend Oreille County Crime Victim Services shall make decisions with regard to selection and retention of sub-contractors, procurement of materials and equipment and similar actions related to the Contract without regard to race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age, marital status, or the presence of any physical, sensory, or mental disability. Compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and RCW 49.60, Law against Discrimination, and other related laws and statutes is required.


