RESOLUTION NO. 2014-10

RE: Mother's Day Marathon

WHEREAS, Priest Lake Multisports LLC has requested permission to conduct the Mother's Day Marathon, May 10, 2014, on LeClerc Road South between the State line and approximately Milepost 8.2, east of the Conklin Meadows Road intersection;

WHEREAS, the Community Development Director is issuing Special Use Permit SUP-14-001 permitting and establishing conditions for the use of land not on the right of way;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has authority to manage the public road right of way and grant permission for use of the road right of way for special events;

WHEREAS, the Sheriff and the County Engineer have reviewed the traffic control plan and the race operation plan;

WHEREAS, the proposed traffic control plan maintains traffic on LeClerc Road South during the event by use of a pilot car system;

WHEREAS; the County Engineer has reviewed traffic conditions along LeClerc Road in the race course and recommends reducing the posted maximum speed limit from 50 MPH to 35 MPH during the event;

NOW, THEREFORE


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that Priest Lake Multisport, LLC is authorized to use LeClerc Road South from the State line to the marathon turnaround point at approximately milepost 8.2 to conduct the Mother's Day Marathon on May 10, 2014, subject to the following conditions:

- Compliance to the conditions of Special Use Permit SUP-14-001 as issued by the Community Development Director
- Receipt of a certificate and endorsement of liability insurance naming Pend Oreille County as an additional insured in the amount of \$1,000,000 per occurrence, \$2,000,000 aggregate
- Compliance with the traffic control plan and operation plan on file with the County Engineer and the Sheriff
- The applicant post and remove speed limit signs on LeClerc Road necessary to implement the revised speed limit during the race as established below
- The applicant acquiring all other permits from other agencies necessary to conduct the race.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the maximum speed limit on LeClerc Road South between milepost 0.00 and 7.261 and between milepost 7.921 and the marathon turnaround point at approximately milepost 8.2 shall be established at 35 MPH during the marathon and the applicant be authorized to post same.


