RESOLUTION NO. 2016-17

RE: Intention to Vacate Landfill Road

Whereas, Pend Oreille County owns all land adjacent to Landfill Road located in Section 28, Township 31 North, Range 45 East, W.M., Pend Oreille County, Washington;

Whereas, Landfill Road separates the South County Transfer Station, Road District 1 shop, District 1 fueling station and the ER&R Fleet Maintenance Facility;

Whereas, the operation of the transfer station would be more efficient if a public county road did not exist between the transfer station and the road district shop;

Whereas, hazards to the public would be reduced if the public access were limited on Landfill Road;

Whereas, security of the county's property, equipment and material stored on both the transfer station and the road district shop would be enhanced if Landfill Road were closed as a public road;

NOW, THEREFORE

IT IS HERBY RESOLVED that it is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners to vacate Landfill Road described as follows:

Landfill Road County Road No. 19010 laying south of Deer Valley Road in Section 28, Township 31 North, Range 45 East, W.M., Pend Oreille County, Washington, excepting there from any utility maintenance easements granted to utility of record;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer is ordered to inspect said road and prepare the Engineer's Report with his/her recommendations on the vacation of the same.
