Pend Oreille County Requirements to Construct Roadway Approach

Requirements are based upon Resolution 74-99

1. Applicant shall mark where they want the approach with flagging, stakes, etc.
2. All cost associated with the construction of the approach to the county road shall be the responsibility of the applicant.
3. The minimum width of any approach shall be 16 feet measured 6 feet beyond the shoulder of the existing county road.
4. The approach shall slope away from the shoulder of the county road with a minimum grade of -2% to a maximum grade of -4% for a distance of 6 feet.
5. No water or materials used in construction of the approach shall drain or be carried on the county road at any time.
6. Maintenance of the approach, cleaning of culvert pipes, and snow removal are the responsibility of the property owner.
7. Sight distance shall be adequate for safety. Adequacy shall be determined by the County Engineer or his assigned counterpart.
8. Work shall be completed within 90 days of the issuance of the permit.

In accepting this permit the applicant, his successors and assigns, agrees to protect and save harmless the County from all claims, actions or damages of any kind and description which may occur to, or be suffered by, any person or persons, corporations, or properties by reason of the performance of any such work, character of materials used or manner of installation, maintenance and operation, or by the improper occupancy or rights-of-way or public structure. If any suit or action is brought against the County for damages arising out of, or by reason of, any of the above causes, the applicant, his successors or assigns will, upon notice to him or her of the commencement of such action, or the defense thereof, at his or her sole cost and expense. He or she will fully satisfy any judgement after the said suit or action shall have finally been determined, if adversely to the County.

Failure to comply with any of the above Permit Requirements shall be cause for revocation of this permit and any thereafter.
