In regard to the proposed Cannabis processing facility. I have attached documents showing the adjacent families living next to the proposed facility and how close it is them. A Cannabis processing facility located this close to families and children in unacceptable. The proposed facility is less than 800ft from Newport State Park and less then 1800ft from the Pend Oreille River. The school bus uses Silver leaf road as a turn around and children wait for the bus at Silver Leaf Road.


Would you like a facility processing marijuana next to your house?
