


This proposition would approve the districts regular property tax levy in order to provide continuing funding for the normal maintenance and operation of the Newport Cemetery. Voter approval would authorize a levy rate of \$0.10, (ten cents), per thousand dollars of assessed property value for collection in 2010 and would permanently authorize the district to exceed the limits of chapter 84.55 RCW based on voter approval. This proposition authorizes the District to acquire land, replace, renovate, construct, equip, and make capital improvements to the District's facilities, and make other capital improvements as part of the District's Comprehensive Plan/Facility Plan, to issue up to \$505,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum of 10 years, and to levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as provided in Resolution No. 09-03.
