Winds in Pend Oreille County

AMENDED EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
NO. 2014-23
(Replacing Emergency Resolution No. 2014-22)

WHEREAS, the Pend Oreille County Department of Emergency Management has reported to the Board of County Commissioners, beginning July 23, 2014 and on August 2, 2014, there were a severe thunderstorms in Pend Oreille County with strong and damaging winds, hail, frequent lightning and heavy rain that caused extensive damage to both public and personal property in Pend Oreille County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Article XI, Section 11 of the Washington State Constitution and RCW 36.32.120 (6) (7), the Board has both the jurisdiction and duty to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of Pend Oreille County; and

WHEREAS, county departments and residents have started taking emergency measures to repair county roads, bridges, private roads, homes, businesses and farmlands as a result of this severe storm; and

WHEREAS, persons and property are and will be damaged unless further efforts are taken to reduce the threat to life and property; and

WHEREAS, there is an emergency present which necessitates activation of the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and utilization of emergency powers granted pursuant to RCW 38.52;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

SECTION 1

That it is hereby declared that there is an emergency due to the conditions in Pend Oreille County; therefore, Public Works, Parks and Recreation and Fairgrounds are authorized to enter into contracts and incur obligations necessary to combat such emergency to protect the health and safety of persons and property, and provide emergency assistance to the victims of such emergency;

SECTION 2


Each designated department is authorized to exercise the powers vested under Section 1 of this resolution in the light of the demands of an extreme emergency situation without regard to time




