



**AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO AGREEMENT NO. WQAIP-2016-PeOCWB-00009
BETWEEN
THE STATE OF WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY
AND
PEND OREILLE COUNTY WEED BOARD**

PURPOSE: To amend the above-referenced agreement (AGREEMENT) between the state of Washington Department of Ecology (ECOLOGY) and Pend Oreille County Weed Board (RECIPIENT) for the Bead Lake Invasive Weeds Eradication Project (PROJECT).

This amendment is needed to add a sub-Task 2-G

Note: This amendment only includes the portions of the original agreement that have been changed in some way. If there were no changes, it will not be referenced in this amendment.

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IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the AGREEMENT is amended as follows:

CHANGES TO SCOPE OF WORK

Task Number: 2 **Task Cost:** \$54,885.00

Task Title: Noxious Weed Survey and Control

Task Description:

- A. The RECIPIENT will conduct surface and sub-surface noxious weed surveys will be conducted annually. The surveys will encompass a wide band following the entire shoreline as the littoral survey for aquatic and emergent noxious weeds.
- B. Infestation sites will be documented with GPS points or polygons. Polygons will include an infestation level cover class description.
- C. Newly identified noxious weed species will be reported immediately to the Weed Board for a mutually developed management plan.
- D. Each season, the RECIPIENT will ensure the residents will conduct whole lake surface and beach monitoring for milfoil fragments, mapping their locations, as well as conducting their collection and disposal.
- E. Annually, the RECIPIENT will ensure the contractor will employ diver assisted suction hand-pulling, as well as bottom barrier installation and removal to all identified milfoil and yellow flag iris infestation sites.
- F. At the conclusion of each season, the contractor will submit a brief report of the activities conducted, including a total tonnage estimate of removed vegetative material.
- G. The contractor will apply herbicide to affected areas that are not responding to hand-pulled treatment.

Task Goal Statement:

The goal of this task is to ensure all noxious weed infestation sites are found and management activities are undertaken to achieve eradication.

Task Expected Outcome:

Eradication of Eurasian watermilfoil and yellow flag iris in Bead Lake. Identification of other noxious weeds if discovered growing in or around Bead Lake; and developing and implementing a management program for those noxious weeds.
