RESOLUTION NO. 2017-11**

Transfer of a vehicle between Solid Waste and Weed Control within the ER&R Fixed Asset System

WHEREAS, RCW 36.33A.020 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to use its discretion to use or not use ER&R to manage vehicles assigned to departments other than the Road Department;

WHEREAS, the Board may use its discretion to determine the proper disposition of current unneeded assets of the County, either by reassignment or disposal;

WHEREAS, a 2005 Chevy Silverado 1500 truck in the ER&R Fixed Asset Inventory System, license 72425C, VIN 1GCEK14V25Z305059, is being replaced this year with a new vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the truck would be useful to the Weed Control Department; and

WHEREAS, the resell value of the truck is used to determine the proper fixed cost rate to be charged for the new replacement vehicle:

WHEREAS, the Fleet Manager has determined that the average of three on-line appraisals for the resell value of the 2005 Chevy Silverado 1500 truck is \$7,392.00;

NOW, THEREFORE

IT IS HERBY RESOLVED that the 2005 Chevy Silverado 1500 truck, license 72452C, VIN 1GCEK14V25Z305059, shall be transferred from Solid Waste System to the Weed Control Department; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that Weed Department shall transfer \$7,392.00 to the ER&R fund to compensate for the resell value of the truck; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the 2005 Chevy Silverado truck license 72452C, VIN 1GCEK14V25Z305059, shall remain in the ER&R Fixed Asset Inventory system assigned to the Weed Department;


IT IS ALSO RESOLVED that effective date of the transfer shall be the date the replacement vehicle is placed in service by ER&R.




