

2017 Annual Work Plan
Noxious Weed Control on District owned Wildlife Management Areas and Specific
Resource Properties
Pend Oreille PUD

Noxious weed treatment by herbicide application on Tacoma Creek and Everett Island Wildlife Management Areas, Finch Island and the Usk property will include backpack, truck-mounted, or UTV mounted weed spray equipment on these PUD managed lands. Spray timing should coincide with the target species phenology to help ensure efficacy of applications. Payment will be issued upon invoice and a copy of all Pesticide Application Records and a brief report included. The invoice shall not exceed \$5,000 total for the wildlife properties. Maps of properties with known infestation sites marked will be provided, as needed, by the PUD. The remaining portion of each property is to be surveyed and additional sites of weed populations are to be noted and treated with the appropriate herbicide as funding allows.
