## *Rustlers Gulch Equestrian Trail*

**Project Location-** Fertile Valley Road near Pend Oreille County Park in Newport, WA

**Construction to begin-** Fall of 2017

### Did You know?

- Baby horses can walk and run just a few hours after they are born
- Horses can sleep both lying down and standing up
- Horses have been used in the police force since 17th century
- In 2003, a horse was cloned for the first time in Italy
- The eyes of horse are bigger than those of any other land mammal



### Trail Features:

- Length of scenic Equestrian Trail- 2.25 miles (approximately)
- Welcome to all non-motorized activities like horse riding, walking, biking
- Connects Pend Oreille Park to Rustlers Gulch
- Trail crosses over Fertile Road 3 times (Sight distance of crossings exceeds safe stopping distance of 425 feet)
