WHEREAS, the Honorable Philip Van de Veer, Judge of the Pend Oreille County District Court, has submitted his resignation to the Board of County Commissioners effective December 31, 2018;

WHEREAS, RCW 3.34.100 provides that the Board of County Commissioners shall fill a vacancy of the elected position of District Court Judge by appointment, and the appointed Judge shall hold office until the next general election and until a successor is elected and qualified;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of RCW 3.34.100, the Board of Pend Oreille County Commissioners desires to fill the District Court Judge position as a result of the resignation of Philip Van de Veer; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners consistent with the provisions of RCW 3.34.100, does hereby appoint Robin McCroskey to the position of Pend Oreille County District Court Judge, effective January 1, 2019, to serve until the next general election and until a successor is elected and qualified, as required by law.


