RESOLUTION NO. 2019-04

RE: Vacation of a portion of Hatchery Road

WHEREAS, Seattle City Light is constructing a new fish hatchery on the same site as the former State fish hatchery in Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 33 North, Range 44 East, W.M., Pend Oreille County, Washington;

WHEREAS, Hatchery Road is a maintained county road that enters into the fish hatchery complex and continues to a turnaround point that served the former fish hatchery complex;

WHEREAS, the new fish hatchery complex design would be better served if Hatchery Road were shortened and a new turnaround constructed;

Whereas, the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife has granted a road right of way that best serves the public and the new fish hatchery;

Whereas, a portion of the maintained Hatchery Road extends beyond the limits of the granted road right of way;

WHEREAS, that portion of Hatchery Road beyond the road right of way granted by the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife appears to be useless to the public road system;

Whereas, RCW 36.87.010 authorizes the Board of Commissioners to initiate a process to vacate a county road or a portion thereof that appear to be useless to the public road system by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that it is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners to vacate and abandon the portion of Hatchery Road that lies between the new turn around point and the former turnaround point all within Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 33 North, Range 44 East, W.M., Pend Oreille County, Washington;


IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners directs the county engineer to report upon such vacation and abandonment.
