RESOLUTION NO. 2019- 24

VACATION OF A PORTION OF HATCHERY ROAD

WHEREAS, the adjacent land owner, being 100 percent of the frontage, has petitioned to vacate that portion of Hatchery Road public right of way extending beyond the limits of the current dedicated right of way in the NW1/4 of the NW1/4, Section 22, Township 33N, Range 44 E.W.M, Pend Oreille County, Washington;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on September 30, 2019 at 1:30 pm to hear the matter;

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has filed his report recommending the vacation be granted;

WHEREAS, the public will receive a benefit by the operation of a new fish hatchery on this site;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that portion of Hatchery Road proposed to be vacated has no current and future use as part of the public road system;

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners finds public is benefited by the vacation of the right of way;




